Most of the content of the other workshops is available in these holiday and school events. Adaptations are the bedrock of creativity so this leads to exciting possibilities depending on the dynamics of groups and the individuals concerned.

The course is based on creating and responding to environments such as sensory tents, tunnels and 'the little room', (Flo Longhorn) natural materials and the elements. Special Educational Needs, P.M.L.D. and AS children have all shown extended periods of concentration, increased social awareness and greater self-esteem during engagement in creativity. These exciting courses are aimed at taking creativity for special needs into natural landscapes where the environment adds its own magical ingredients.
